





Looking Back, Gearing Up

Like most folks, I enjoy reviewing and savoring past accomplishments from time to time. But always with one eye on the future.

That's how I'm feeling as I pen this message. At BIG1 Giving, even as BIG1 Members in some countries continued to struggle through economic recoveries, 2024 gave us some significant reasons to celebrate. We logged – or rather, you logged – another 25 million plus Impacts, a reflection of the seemingly unstoppable generosity of you and your respective teams.

We also added two new Worthy Causes to our burgeoning portfolio – now numbering 82 Worthy Causes, with more than 450 projects in 48 countries. And, thanks to your generosity, we were able to support critical relief efforts in response to the devastation caused by Hurricane Helene in the United States.

Importantly, speaking of celebrations, after a hiatus of more than 5 years, we were finally able to bring back our super-popular B1G1 Study Tour (the non-virtual version). Focused on several of our Worthy Cause partners in Cambodia, the 2024 Tour was, as always, both eye-opening and heartwarming for everyone involved. Among other activities, Study Tour participants delivered bicycles to This Life Cambodia beneficiaries who previously made long journeys every day from their village to attend school. On another day, Tour participants and Child's Dream representatives rolled up their sleeves, weathering four hours of hard work, sore backs and blistered hands to build a playground for children at the Phnum Leab Primary School. While our Virtual Study Tours over the past several years have been very well-received, there is nothing quite like visiting with on-the-ground teams from our Worthy Causes, learning about their work, lending a helping hand, and meeting the many beneficiaries they serve every day. It truly is a moving experience.

As the year ended, we focused attention on some internal Board processes, to make sure we are following best nonprofit management practices. We were also very fortunate to identify a highly-qualified candidate to add to the B1G1 Giving Board – Yannis Apostolopoulos – who formally joined the Board at its February 2025 meeting. With this new Board seat filled, we feel we are well-positioned for the 2025 growth plans of B1G1 Pte. Ltd.

Our heartfelt thanks go out to all of you – B1G1 Members and their employees, Worthy Cause partners and their teams, and the many supporters of the B1G1 Movement all around the world – for your generosity and your commitment to make the world a better, safer, and more giving place.



The last Study Tour we hosted before the pandemic was in October 2019. And finally, we managed to host our first Study Tour in 5 years. Visiting some of the Worthy Causes that have grown significantly made us realise the power of long-term efforts.

Seeing the real progress made on the lives of people and key initiatives, we felt the enormous sense of gratitude for everyone involved in the collective work for the past 18 years.

Improved alignment with the B1G1 initiative focus

As the B1G1 initiative worked through important reflections in 2024 to re-identify as a community centric, member-driven initiative, we recognised the importance of the role the B1G1 Worthy Causes play in creating the deeper sense of connection - through better story-telling and meaningful content sharing.

We hosted a session to introduce some of these ideas with the Worthy Cause representatives and also invited many of them to participate in regional member events.

Updated Worthy Cause dashboard development

So far, the B1G1 platform was primarily designed for B1G1 Business Members. But finally, we decided it's about time that we also make a significant improvement in the Worthy Cause user dashboard.

And as a result, we came up with some simple yet useful changes to make it easier for our Worthy Causes to send in their project updates or compliance documents. Of course, there is so much more to be done. But we have taken important steps forward.

Inspiring Beneficiary Stories From B1G1 Worthy Causes

IRENE

Through a conversation with Five Talents, they shared the deeply moving and inspiring story of Irene, a woman who went from struggling in poverty to becoming an empowered entrepreneur and leader in her community.

It's a story that perfectly embodies how micro-impacts can transform not only individuals but entire communities for generations to come.

Irene's journey began in the most modest of ways. She lived in poverty, lacked literacy skills, and had little hope for a different future. However, with the support of Five Talents, Irene learned to read and to count — the things we take for granted.



She was now able to read signs (AND count the change she was given when she bought things! And that led to her first tiny opportunity: an initial loan to buy mice . Yes, mice (a source of protein when you can't afford meat). She learned to breed the mice — not the most conventional start to a business, but that small spark allowed Irene to build her first enterprise.

From that initial step, Irene's business grew. She bought rabbits (they bred too), then chickens which provided eggs to make cakes. She began to employ other women, earning not just income but also the respect of her community.

Today, Irene has multiple enterprises. What started as a humble chance became a profound transformation—not just for her but for those around her. Irene is now recognized as a leader, someone who inspires and uplifts others.

The ripple effects of stories like Irene's go far beyond what is visible on the surface. Irene's success is not just about her own achievements. By employing others, she became a multiplier of opportunities, spreading hope to other women in her village. This cascading effect is why B1G1 focuses on supporting initiatives that create leaders. Leaders like Irene inspire their communities to rise up, take charge, and sustain positive change.

ALICE

You've just got to love that "SHE-E-O's" title, haven't you?

In partnership with B1G1 since 2013, Microloan Foundation Australia is dedicated to empowering women in some of the most marginalized communities across the globe.

By offering small loans, business training and mentorship, they enable women to start and grow their own businesses, lifting themselves and their families out of poverty. Over 450,000 female entrepreneurs have been supported to date.

Alice Zulu, one of the many benefactors of their projects, shares her story of hope and success after receiving support from the Worthy Cause.

Alice acquired the necessary agricultural inputs to cultivate maize and soya, ensuring food security for her family despite adversities like termite infestation and erratic rainfall.

"We can afford to purchase what we need to produce good crops. I used to only be able to buy one bag of seeds, but now I can buy two plus fertilizer and pesticides if I need them."

She also diversified her income streams by venturing into microenterprise, establishing a bakery and a chip shop with previous loans.

Since receiving her first loan in 2018, Alice's life has undergone a remarkable transformation — she has built a house, improved her family's living conditions, and gained financial independence.
